- 2 Baby dolls
- 2 Diaper Project diapers
- 60 second countdown clock [download link]
- Small table

STORYTELLING SCRIPT

STORYTELLER: Hey kids! Great to see all of you again! _____ here! Reporting for duty as your amazing tour guide! Today we will continue our tour around the world as we learn more about “The Diaper Project”. First, let’s recap! Yesterday, we talked about the diaper and how the diaper made by “The Diaper Project” is so important because it can be re-used for years so parents will always have a diaper to keep babies healthy even without a store to buy diapers from.

That brings us to today! What will be in our suitcase today? Do you have any ideas? Let’s hear them!

Storyteller pauses to hear children’s ideas

Those are some great ideas! So let’s open the suitcase and see what we can find!

Storyteller opens suitcase and pulls out coloring book

Look at this cool coloring book! I wonder what’s inside!

Storyteller flips through pages of coloring book

That is so neat! It tells how to use our diapers! Would you like to learn how to use them? Awesome! Well, let me show you! Now, watch very closely because you will need to know how!

At this point host will need small table, baby doll, and diaper to facilitate the next exercise

We have this baby!

Storyteller holds up the baby doll in one hand

Now we will put this diaper on here!

Storyteller holds up the Diaper Project diaper in the other hand

We pick up the baby and lay down the diaper open and flat, then we set the baby on top. Make sure the diaper is right above the waist. Now, you will bring the part up to the belly button and close it on the tightest snap you can without squeezing the baby so it doesn't fall off! Now pick up your baby and make sure it stays on!!

Storyteller holds up the baby and shakes it in a silly manner

You think you got it? Since you were paying such close attention, we are going to play a little game!

You will need two kids from the crowd to play this game. They both will need a baby doll and a Diaper Project diaper

Now, we need two volunteers from the crowd!

Storyteller picks two kids out of the crowd to volunteer

Alright, the rules are, when I say "GO!", you are going to race and put the diaper on your baby! Don't forget to shake at the end to make sure it stays on!

You have 60 seconds. Are you ready? Set! GO!!

CG: 60 second countdown clock

Great job!! You guys rock! In other countries, we don't have contests to test moms to see if they can put on diapers. So these coloring books get passed around the villages and they are written in different languages so the moms can see and read how to use the diaper they receive! These coloring books are an important tool for us to use to educate the parents who will use "The Diaper Project's" diapers! Today, you will get to see a sample of the coloring book! But it is a lot of work to get these coloring books in other countries and in the hands of the parents!

So, how do they get diapers and coloring books to the ground? We will dig into this more tomorrow ... Bye!
